Access to HE courses offer a fast-track to university

Teaching, Law, Social Work, Nursing, Design, Policing... the list goes on!

Access to HE courses are one year courses designed for adults aged 19 and over who are returning to education with the ambition of studying for a degree.

Access courses will give you the UCAS points you need to secure a university place and equip you with all the skills you need to be able to study at degree level.

Search Access to HE on the college's website for all our Access courses.

And...if you don't yet have your maths and English grades you can study these for free with us too.

You may be able to study for **FREE**

There are a few ways you may be able to study for free. Eligibility criteria is based on your personal circumstances and/or your choice of course. This is subject to criteria that is either based on your personal circumstances or your choice of course.

1

If you do not currently hold a Level 2 qualification in English or maths (a GCSE grade 4-9 or equivalent in these subjects) then you can study these for **free**.

2

If you already hold a Level 2 qualification and are aged 19-23, unemployed, in receipt of certain benefits or your individual income is below £20,319 or household income is £35,000 GROSS, you could be eligible for fee remission on undertaking another Level 2 course.*

3

A Level 3 qualification could be paid for by an Advanced Learner Loan, unless you are 19-23 years old and the course has legal entitlement. This funding will only apply if the qualification is your first Level 3 qualification.

4

If you are over the age of 19, employed (earning less than £20,319) or unemployed, and do not hold a full Level 3 qualification from the past 2 years (equivalent to at least two A Levels, or a Level 3 vocational qualification) you can now access free training for a range of in-demand skills as part of the National Skills Fund.

Funding for those aged 19+ applying for a Level 3 or higher level course.

If you don't meet the criteria for fee remission, then the Advanced Learner Loan is there to help with the cost of your course fees. You don't have to pay any of your loan back until you've started earning over £27,295 a year and any outstanding balance is automatically written off 30 years after your scheduled qualification end date.

If you use an Advanced Learner Loan to fund an Access to Higher Education course and progress to university on completion, your loan will be written off.


